

- Register online** with full payment.
- This program does not qualify for Financial Aid. You can contact local nursing homes for assistance, or your local Ohio Means Jobs office.
- If a local nursing home will cover tuition cost, the student will need to complete the registration form and have the Director of Nursing or Administrator of the facility complete the “Third Party Pay” section on the last page of the **registration form**. This can be emailed to adultregistration@apollocc.org or turned into the Adult Education Office.

Program Requirements

- This class has a 100% attendance policy.
- Current 2-step Mantoux (TB) test (within 3 months). . The TB Test will be done during class time at no additional cost to the student. If you are currently working in healthcare and had your original 2-step TB test, and have maintained your yearly updates (within 3 months), bring copies of those results with you to class.
- Uniform, including a white scrub top, navy uniform pants/skirt and white shoes will be required beginning the first day of the second week of class.
- All students are required to complete fingerprinting prior to orientation. Fingerprinting can be completed by stopping in to the Adult Education office Monday through Thursday between 9am & 5pm. Students under the age of 18 will need a signed parent consent form or parent present at fingerprinting. Photo ID is also required for fingerprinting.
