\*Immunization documentation of previously completed vaccines or documentation of history of disease are accepted. Vaccines would not need to be repeated. Your health insurance may cover the cost of these vaccines. *Students must be up-to-date in their series by week 4 of the class.* Proof of current AHA HCP Level CPR will be accepted and would not need to be repeated but renewed to keep validity through completion of clinicals.

\*\*There is NO set scrub brand for the phlebotomy class program. Students will be required to wear black or red scrubs beginning the first day of class. It does not matter where they are purchased.

Program Orientation for this class is the **Thursday BEFORE** the advertised start date.
