Apollo Career Center, hereinafter referred to as “The Driving School” agrees to provide applicant, hereinafter referred to as “Student”, 24 hours of classroom instruction and 8 hours of practical driving instruction based on the Ohio Driver Training Curriculum. Regulations prohibit more than four hours of training to be conducted in one day. The Driving School shall furnish a licensed instructor and a motor vehicle for instruction. The course consists of eight (8) three (3) hour classes for a total of twenty-four (24) hours of classroom instruction and eight (8) hours of BTW (Behind the Wheel) practice driving after successfully completing the classroom portion. _____ (date) Students must attend all classes and be on time. Students must score a 75% or better on the final exam to pass the classroom portion. The Driving School does not guarantee the issuance of a state driver license to the Student. The tuition for said instruction is \$330.00. The Driving School will loan the Student a textbook for use during enrollment at the driving school. A fee of \$100.00 will be charged for any book not returned or returned damaged. The Apollo Career Center Driver Education School does not provide loaner cars/rental of cars for testing.

The Student may begin classroom instruction, at the age 15 years and 5 months, before obtaining a temporary driving permit. However, the Student is required to obtain a valid temporary driving permit prior to scheduling the practical driving portion of the course. The Student will need a picture I.D. & copy of Temps with them to drive with an instructor. The entire course must be completed within six (6) months of the start date, and if not, all classes and associated costs must be repeated.

The Driving School reserves the right to cancel this agreement at any time, should the Student for unruly behavior or misconduct and will not be given a refund. This includes any Student conduct that indicates a lack of responsibility deemed necessary by The Driving School to safely operate a motor vehicle. Driver Training Schools are licensed by the Department of Public Safety through the Driver Training Program Office, 1970 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43223. The Department of Public Safety mandates that parents must sign this application, granting their child permission to take Drivers Education, in the presence of a school official.
